PEOPLE IN THESE UNITS COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE MOUSING UNITS. PEUPLE IN THESE UNITS CUMPLETED THE "LUNG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE.
