SUPPRESSION CAN OCCUR IF THERE ARE FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY, FEWER THAN 10 HOUSEHOLDS OR FAMILIES, OR FEWER THAN 10 UNITS IN A HOUSING CATEGORY. SEVERAL TABLES OF BASIC COUNTS ARE NEVER SUPPRESSION MAY HAVE OCCURRED IN THAT TABLE.
