PEOPLE IN THESE UNITS COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE. IN INCORPORATED PLACES WITH 2.500 OR MORE INHABITANTS. EVERY SIXTH HOUSEHOLD RECEIVED THE LONG QUESTIONNAIRE. IN RUBAL AREAS AND INCORPORATED PLACES WITH FEWER THAN 2.500 INHABITANTS. ONE OF EVERY TWO HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED THE LONG FORM.
