SUPPRESSION CAN OCCUR IF THERE ARE FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY, FEWER THAN 10 HOUSEHOLDS OR FAMILIES, OR FEWER THAN 10 UNITS IN A HOUSING CATEGORY. SEVERAL TABLES OF BASIC COUNTS ARE NEVER SUPPRESSED. AN ASTERIUK (*) AFTER A TABLE NAME INDICATES THAT SUPPRESSION MAY HAVE OCCURRED IN THAT TABLE.

- (5) THE FOLLOWING ARE EXCLUDED FROM TABULATIONS ON VALUE FOR NONCONDOMINIUM UNITS: UNITS AT AN ADDRESS WITH 2 OR MORE UNITS. UNITS ON 10 OR MORE ACRES. UNITS WITH A COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT OR MEDICAL OFFICE ON THE PROPERTY. AND MEDILE HOMES OR TRAILERS.
- (6) SELECTED MONTHLY OWNER COSTS REFER TO THE SUM OF PAYMENTS FUR REAL ESTATE TAXES, PROPERTY INSURANCE, UTILITIES, AND REGULAR MORTGAGE PAYMENTS.
- (7) GROSS RENT AND CONTRACT RENT ARE TABULATED FOR ALL RENTER-OCCUPIED UNITS DIXCEPT ONE-FAMILY HOMES ON A PROPERTY OF 10 OR MORE ACRES. GROSS RENT 13 THE SUM OF CONTRACT RENT AND UTILITY COSTS.
- (8) UTILITIES INCLUDE ELECTRICITY. GAS. WATER. AND DIL. COAL. KEROSENE. WOOD. STC.
