FEWER THAN 15 PERSONS. IN A RACIAL CATEGORY. FEWER THAN 5 HOUSEHOLDS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY. OR FEWER THAN 5 UNITS IN A HOUSING CATEGORY. SEVERAL TABLES OF BASIC COUNTS ARE NEVER SUPPRESSED.
