A FEW ADDITIONAL COMMENTS ARE NOTED AT THE END OF THIS REPORT. ACCORDING TO THE CENSUS BUREAU, THIS PLACE HAD A TOTAL OF 1027 HOUSING UNITS IN 1980. THE DATA IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON A SAMPLE OF 510 OF THE HOUSING UNITS. PEOPLE IN THESE UNITS COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS GUESTIONNAIRE.
