PEOPLE IN THESE UNITS COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE. IN INCORPORATED PLACES WITH 2,500 OR MORE INHABITANTS. EVERY SIXTH HOUSEHOLD RECEIVED THE LONG QUESTIONNAIRE. IN RURAL AREAS AND INCORPORATED PLACES WITH FEWER THAN 2,500 INHABITANTS. ONE OF EVERY TWO HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED THE LONG FORM. THE BUREAU SUPPRESSES TABULATIONS OF CHARACTERISTICS OF VERY SMALL GROUPS OF PEOPLE OR HOUSING UNITS. SUPPRESSION CAN OCCUR IF THERE ARE FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY, FEWER THAN 10 HOUSEHOLDS OR FAMILIES, OR FEWER THAN 10 UNITS IN A HOUSING CATEGORY.
