FOR DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED IN THIS REPORT, PLEASE REFER TO INTRODUCTIONS AND APPENDICES OF POPULATION AND HOUSING PUBLICATIONS OF THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS.

IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN CONFIDENTIALITY AS REQUIRED BY LAW, IT IS NECESSARY FOR THE CENSUS BUREAU TO MAKE SURE THAT ITS PUBLIC DATA DO NOT DISCLOSE INFORMATION ABOUT ANY INDIVIDUAL. THE BUREAU SUPPRESSES TABULATIONS OF CHARACTERISTICS OF VERY SMALL GROUPS OF PEOPLE OR HOUSING UNITS. SUPPRESSION CAN OCCUR IF THERE ARE FEWER THAN 15 PERSONS IN A GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FEWER THAN 15 PERSONS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY, FEWER THAN 5 HOUSEHOLDS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY, OR FEWER THAN 5 UNITS IN A HOUSING CATEGORY. SEVERAL TABLES OF BASIC COUNTS ARE NEVER SUPPRESSED. AN ASTERISK (\*) AFTER A TABLE NAME INDICATES THAT SUPPRESSION MAY HAVE OCCURRED IN THAT TABLE.

FOR DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED IN THIS REPORT, PLEASE REFER TO INTRODUCTIONS AND APPENDICES OF POPULATION REPORTS OF THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS. A FEW ADDITIONAL COMMENTS ARE NOTED AT THE END OF THIS REPORT.

ACCORDING TO THE CENSUS BUREAU, THIS PLACE HAD A TOTAL OF 6313 RESIDENTS IN 1980. THE DATA IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON A SAMPLE OF 984 OF THE RESIDENTS OF THIS PLACE. THESE PEOPLE COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE. IN INCORPORATED PLACES WITH AT LEAST 2,500 INHABITANTS, EVERY SIXTH HOUSEHOLD RECEIVED THE LONG QUESTIONNAIRE. IN RURAL AREAS AND INCORPORATED PLACES WITH FEWER THAN 2,500 INHABITANTS, ONE OF EVERY TWO HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED THE LONG FORM. THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS THEN USED A COMPLEX PROCEDURE TO WEIGHT THE SAMPLE DATA SO THAT THEY REPRESENT ALL RESIDENTS OF THIS PLACE.

PEOPLE IN THESE UNITS COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE. IN INCORPORATED PLACES WITH 2,500 OR MORE INHABITANTS, EVERY SIXTH HOUSEHOLD RECEIVED THE LONG QUESTIONNAIRE. IN RURAL AREAS AND INCORPORATED PLACES WITH FEWER THAN 2,500 INHABITANTS, ONE OF EVERY TWO HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED THE LONG FORM. THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS THEN USED A COMPLEX PROCEDURE TO WEIGHT THE SAMPLE DATA SO THAT THEY REPRESENT ALL HOUSING UNITS AND RESIDENTS OF THIS PLACE.

SUPPRESSION CAN OCCUR IF THERE ARE FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FEWER THAN 30 PERSONS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY, FEWER THAN 10 HOUSEHOLDS OR FAMILIES, OR FEWER THAN 10 UNITS IN A HOUSING CATEGORY. SEVERAL TABLES OF BASIC COUNTS ARE NEVER SUPPRESSED. AN ASTERISK (\*) AFTER A TABLE NAME INDICATES THAT SUPPRESSION MAY HAVE OCCURRED IN THAT TABLE.

(2) THIS AND OTHER AGGREGATES, ALONG WITH THE RELEVANT COUNTS, PERMIT THE COMPUTATION OF MEANS. FOR EXAMPLE, THE AGGREGATED ROOMS DIVIDED BY THE NUMBER OF YEAR-ROUND HOUSING UNITS YIELDS THE MEAN NUMBER OF ROOMS PER YEAR-ROUND HOUSING UNIT.

(3) ASIAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER INCLUDES JAPANESE, CHINESE, FILIPINO, KOREAN, ASIAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER, VIETNAMESE, HAWAIIAN, GUAMANIAN, SAMOAN, AND THOSE PERSONS WHO HAVE A WRITE-IN ENTRY OF AN ASIAN OR PACIFIC ISLANDER GROUP IN THE "OTHER" CATEGORY.

(4) VEHICLES INCLUDE AUTOMOBILES, TRUCKS, AND VANS.

(5) THE FOLLOWING ARE EXCLUDED FROM TABULATIONS ON VALUE FOR NONCONDOMINIUM UNITS: UNITS AT AN ADDRESS WITH 2 OR MORE UNITS, UNITS ON 10 OR MORE ACRES, UNITS WITH A COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT OR MEDICAL OFFICE ON THE PROPERTY, AND MOBILE HOMES OR TRAILERS.

(6) SELECTED MONTHLY OWNER COSTS REFER TO THE SUM OF PAYMENTS FOR REAL ESTATE TAXES, PROPERTY INSURANCE, UTILITIES, AND REGULAR MORTGAGE PAYMENTS.

(7) GROSS RENT AND CONTRACT RENT ARE TABULATED FOR ALL RENTER-OCCUPIED UNITS EXCEPT ONE-FAMILY HOMES ON A PROPERTY OF 10 OR MORE ACRES. GROSS RENT IS THE SUM OF CONTRACT RENT AND UTILITY COSTS.

(8) UTILITIES INCLUDE ELECTRICITY, GAS, WATER, AND OIL, COAL, KEROSENE, WOOD, ETC.
