
Iowa City, IA

Iowa City is one of 366 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2007 population of 146,690 ranked 261st in the nation.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Iowa City had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$36,164. This PCPI ranked 116th in the United States and was 94 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Iowa City was \$24,224 and ranked 122nd in the United States. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.3 percent.



In 2007 lowa City had a total personal income ($\underline{\text{TPI}}$) of \$5,304,865*. This TPI ranked 232nd in the United States. In 1997 the TPI of lowa City was \$3,077,644* and ranked 247th in the United States

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Iowa City.
