THESE PROPLE COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE. IN INCORPORATED PLACES WITH AT LEAST 2.500 INHABITANTS. FVERY SIXTH HOUSEHOLD RECRIVED THE LONG QUESTIONNAIPE. IN RURAL AREAS AND INCORPORATED PLACES WITH FEWER THAN 2.500 INHABITANTS. ONE OF EVERY TWO HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED THE LONG FORM. THE BURFAU OF THE CENSUS THEN USED A COMPLEX PROCEDURE TO WEIGHT THE SAMPLE DATA SO THAT THEY REPRESENT ALL RESIDENTS OF THIS PLACE.
