THESE PEOPLE COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE. IN INCORPORATED PLACES WITH AT LEAST 2,500 INHABITANTS, EVERY SIXTH HOUSEHOLD RECEIVED THE LONG QUESTIONNAIRE. IN RURAL AREAS AND INCORPORATED PLACES WITH FEWER THAN 2,500 INHABITANTS, ONE OF EVERY TWO HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED THE LONG FORM. THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS THEN USED A COMPLEX PROCEDURE TO WEIGHT THE SAMPLE DATA SO THAT THEY REPRESENT ALL RESIDENTS OF THIS PLACE.

SEVERAL TABLES OF BASIC COUNTS ARE NEVER SUPPRESSED. AN ASTERISK (*) AFTER A TABLE NAME INDICATES THAT SUPPRESSION MAY HAVE OCCURRED IN THAT TABLE.

- (6) SELECTED MONTHLY DWNER COSTS REFER TO THE SUM OF PAYMENTS FOR REAL ESTATE TAXES, PROPERTY INSURANCE, UTILITIES, AND REGULAR MORTGAGE PAYMENTS.
- (7) GROSS RENT AND CONTRACT RENT ARE TABULATED FOR ALL RENTER-OCCUPIED UNITS EXCEPT ONE-FAMILY HOMES ON A PROPERTY OF 10 OR MORE ACRES. GROSS RENT IS THE SUM OF CONTRACT RENT AND UTILITY COSTS.
- (8) UTILITIES INCLUDE ELECTRICITY, GAS, WATER, AND DIL, COAL, KEROSENE, WOOD, ETC.
