IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN CONFIDENTIALITY AS REQUIRED BY LAW, IT IS NECESSARY FOR THE CENSUS BUREAU TO MAKE SURE THAT ITS PUBLIC DATA DO NOT DISCLOSE INFORMATION ABOUT ANY INDIVIDUAL. THE BUREAU SUPPRESSES TABULATIONS OF CHARACTERISTICS OF VERY SMALL GROUPS OF PEOPLE OR HOUSING UNITS. SUPPRESSION CAN OCCUR IF THERE ARE FEWER THAN 15 PERSONS IN A GEOGRAPHIC AREA, FEWER THAN 15 PERSONS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY, FEWER THAN 5 HOUSEHOLDS IN A RACIAL CATEGORY. OR FEWER THAN 5 UNITS IN A HOUSING CATEGORY. SEVERAL TABLES OF BASIC COUNTS ARE NEVER SUPPRESSION MAY HAVE OCCURRED IN THAT TABLE. IN COLUMNS WHERE SUPPRESSION DID OCCUR, NO NUMBERS WILL BE PRESENT. BUT IN COLUMNS WHERE SOME NUMBERS ARE PRESENT, BLANKS USUALLY CAN BE TREATED AS ZEROS.

ACCORDING TO THE CENSUS BUREAU, THIS COUNTY HAD A TOTAL OF 19533 RESIDENTS IN 1980. THE DATA IN THIS REPORT ARE BASED ON A SAMPLE OF 5892 OF THE RESIDENTS OF THIS CCUNTY. THESE PEOPLE COMPLETED THE "LONG FORM" OF THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE. IN INCORPORATED PLACES WITH AT LEAST 2,500 INHABITANTS, EVERY SIXTH HOUSEHOLD RECEIVED THE LONG QUELTIONNAIRE. IN RURAL AREAS AND INCORPORATED PLACES WITH FEWER THAN 2,5\0 INHABITANTS, ONE OF EVERY TWO HOUSEHOLDS RECEIVED THE LONG FORM. THE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS THEN USED A COMPLEX PROCEDURE TO WEIGHT THE SAMPLE DATA SO THAT THEY REPRESENT ALL RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTY. 5892

(6) SELECTED MONTHLY OWNER COSTS REFER TO THE SUM OF PAYMENTS FOR REAL ESTATE TAXES, PROPERTY INSURANCE, UTILITIES, AND REGULAR MORTGAGE PAYMENTS.

(7) GROSS RENT AND CONTRACT RENT ARE TABULATED FOR ALL RENTER-OCCUPIED UNITS EXCEPT ONE-FAMILY HOMES ON A PROPERTY OF 10 DR MORE ACRES. GROSS RENT IS THE SUM OF CONTRACT RENT AND UTILITY COSTS.
