Census 2000 used four sampling rates to arrive at estimates for areas differing in the density of population. Blocks in an entity (such as counties and incorporated places) with an estimated occupied housing unit count of fewer than 800 units were sampled at 1-in-2, while blocks in an entity with an estimated occupied housing unit count of at least 800 but fewer than 1,200 units were sampled at 1-in-4.
