Census 2000 used four sampling rates to arrive at estimates for areas differing in the density of population. Blocks in an entity (such as counties and incorporated places) with an estimated occupied housing unit count of fewer than 800 units were sampled at 1-in-2, while blocks in an entity with an estimated occupied housing unit count of at least 800 but fewer than 1,200 units were sampled at 1-in-4. The sampling rate was 1-in-6 housing units for blocks with 1,200 to 1,999 housing units. Blocks with an estimated 2,000 or more occupied housing units were sampled at 1-in-8. For persons living in group quarters, the sampling rate was 1-in-6. The results were then weighted to represent the total population of incorporated places, counties, and the state.

NOTE: Challenges to the total population and housing counts can be filed for geographic areas. If such challenges are upheld, then the final counts of total population and/or total housing units could differ from those reported on these pages. However, other numbers on these pages will not be adjusted by the bureau.

NOTE: Numbers on the SF3 pages may differ from those for items also reported on the SF1 pages. The SF3 data are based on a sample of households while the SF1 pages report information from all households.
