



## Appanoose, Iowa

Appanoose is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 12,986 ranked 60th in the state.

## PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Appanoose had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,337. This PCPI ranked 96th in the state and was 73 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 66 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.5 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Appanoose was \$18,106 and ranked 97th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.




