



Boone, Iowa

Boone is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is part of the Boone, IA Micropolitan SA. Its 2007 population of 26,355 ranked 24th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Boone had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$35,131. This PCPI ranked 17th in the state and was 101 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 91 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 5.4 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Boone was \$24,001 and ranked 18th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.




