



Calhoun, Iowa

Calhoun is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 9,962 ranked 77th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Calhoun had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,364. This PCPI ranked 42nd in the state and was 96 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 86 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 15.1 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Calhoun was \$22,165 and ranked 55th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.





TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME



In 2007 Calhoun had a total personal income (TPI) of \$332,371*. This TPI ranked 74th in the state and accounted for 0.3 percent of the state total. In 1997 the TPI of Calhoun was \$252,171* and ranked 72nd in the state.

Note: Total personal income estimates are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.

COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Calhoun.
