



## Davis, Iowa

Davis is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 8,560 ranked 85th in the state.

## PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Davis had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,108. This PCPI ranked 98th in the state and was 72 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 65 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Davis was \$18,501 and ranked 94th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.




