



Mills, Iowa

Mills is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is part of the Omaha-Council Bluffs, NE-IA (MSA). Its 2007 population of 15,123 ranked 54th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Mills had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$38,051. This PCPI ranked 6th in the state and was 109 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 99 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.3 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Mills was \$26,527 and ranked 4th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.




