


Washington, Iowa

Washington is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is part of the Iowa City, IA (MSA). Its 2007 population of 21,236 ranked 28th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Washington had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$34,457. This PCPI ranked 29th in the state and was 99 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 89 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.5 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Washington was \$25,492 and ranked 8th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.1 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.




