



## Wayne, Iowa

Wayne is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 6,269 ranked 96th in the state.

## PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Wayne had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,134. This PCPI ranked 94th in the state and was 75 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 68 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 11.7 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Wayne was \$18,304 and ranked 95th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.




