



Wright, Iowa

Wright is one of 99 counties in Iowa. It is not part of a Metropolitan Area. Its 2007 population of 13,021 ranked 59th in the state.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Wright had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$37,134. This PCPI ranked 8th in the state and was 106 percent of the state average, \$34,916, and 96 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 9.4 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Wright was \$24,623 and ranked 12th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.0 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.




