



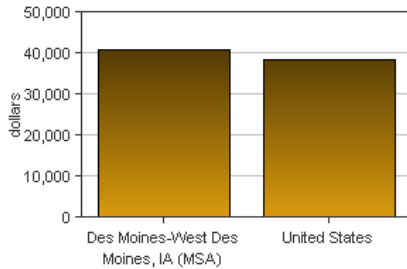
Des Moines-West Des Moines (MSA)

Des Moines-West Des Moines is one of 366 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2007 population of 545,669 ranked 91st in the nation.

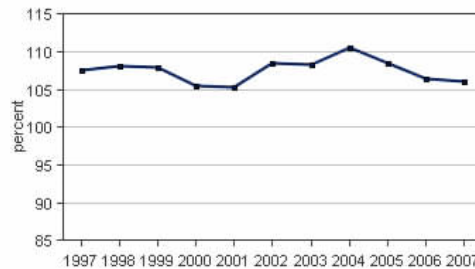
PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2007 Des Moines-West Des Moines had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$40,923. This PCPI ranked 53rd in the United States and was 106 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 4.5 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Des Moines-West Des Moines was \$27,236 and ranked 45th in the United States. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.3 percent.

Per Capita Income as a Percent of the United States, 2007



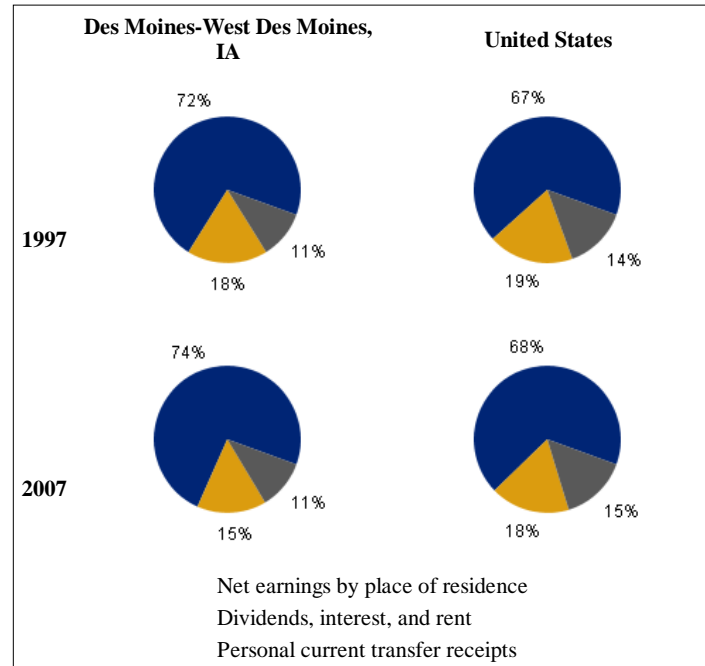
